A brand new look and feel with this mixed case—Not just one, not even two, but THREE different wines from three different producers. A true mix of great, value-oriented White Burgs for the "everyday" portion of your home fridge.

We know from first-hand experience how difficult it is to find reliably good Burgundy when out shopping in a store. Often all you can find are mass-produced negociant bottlings, or producers you've never heard of, and you're paying \$30-\$40 or more for what amounts to a shot in the dark. It doesn't have to be that hard!

Seeking out the wines for this club is one of the most rewarding tasks for us twice per year. Quite reilably, the top end in Burgundy delivers something incredible, but those "a ha!" moments for the everyday price tag are fewer and farther between

This fall we posed the challenge to three of our "go to" guys--Pablo Chevrot, Thiébault Huber, and Christophe Thibert. And they came through...big time!













Thirty years of winemaking and experimentation with the monocépage Chardonnay has given Christophe Thibert a wealth of knowledge on the subject.

The hierarchy in the Mâconnais goes like this - the very basic, lowest-level wines are labeled simply as "Mâcon". Next step up is is "Mâcon-Villages", made from grapes from any number of villages in the region. Then, the best wines from the best Villages are designated as "Mâcon + Village name" - and that's what we have here, a "Mâcon-Verzé".

This beauty is honeyed and tart at the same time, a lovely bottle of white burgundy for the pricetag. The Thibert parcel is on a gentle slope above the village, on well-drained limestone over a mix of chalk and clay. It's the clay that brings the richness and power, and the limestone that drives the freshness and mineral undertones on this astonishingly complete and complex wine.

Vinified and aged 10% in used Burgundy barrels and 90% in stainless steel - this wine is THE whole package, all wrapped up in a pretty \$24 bow.
